

Reproductive Freedom Is on the Ballot This November in Michigan

Abortion is health care, and health care is solely the business between patients and their providers. Politicians do not belong in clinics or doctor's offices. YOUR right to decide health care is on the line; voting YES on proposition 3 protects your rights. Clinicians should not be imprisoned for practicing safe and effective health care.



Vote YES on proposition 3 and put protected reproductive health care in Michigan's constitution!

Ballot Language: Proposal 22-3

A proposal to amend the state constitution to establish new individual right to reproductive freedom, including right to make all decisions about pregnancy and abortion; allow state to regulate abortion in some cases; and forbid prosecution of individuals exercising established right

Voting YES on Prop 3 will protect abortion access and a range of reproductive freedoms, including:

- The right to safe and respectful care during birth
- The right to use or refuse temporary or permanent birth control
- Protection against prosecution for pregnancy outcomes (miscarriage, etc.)
